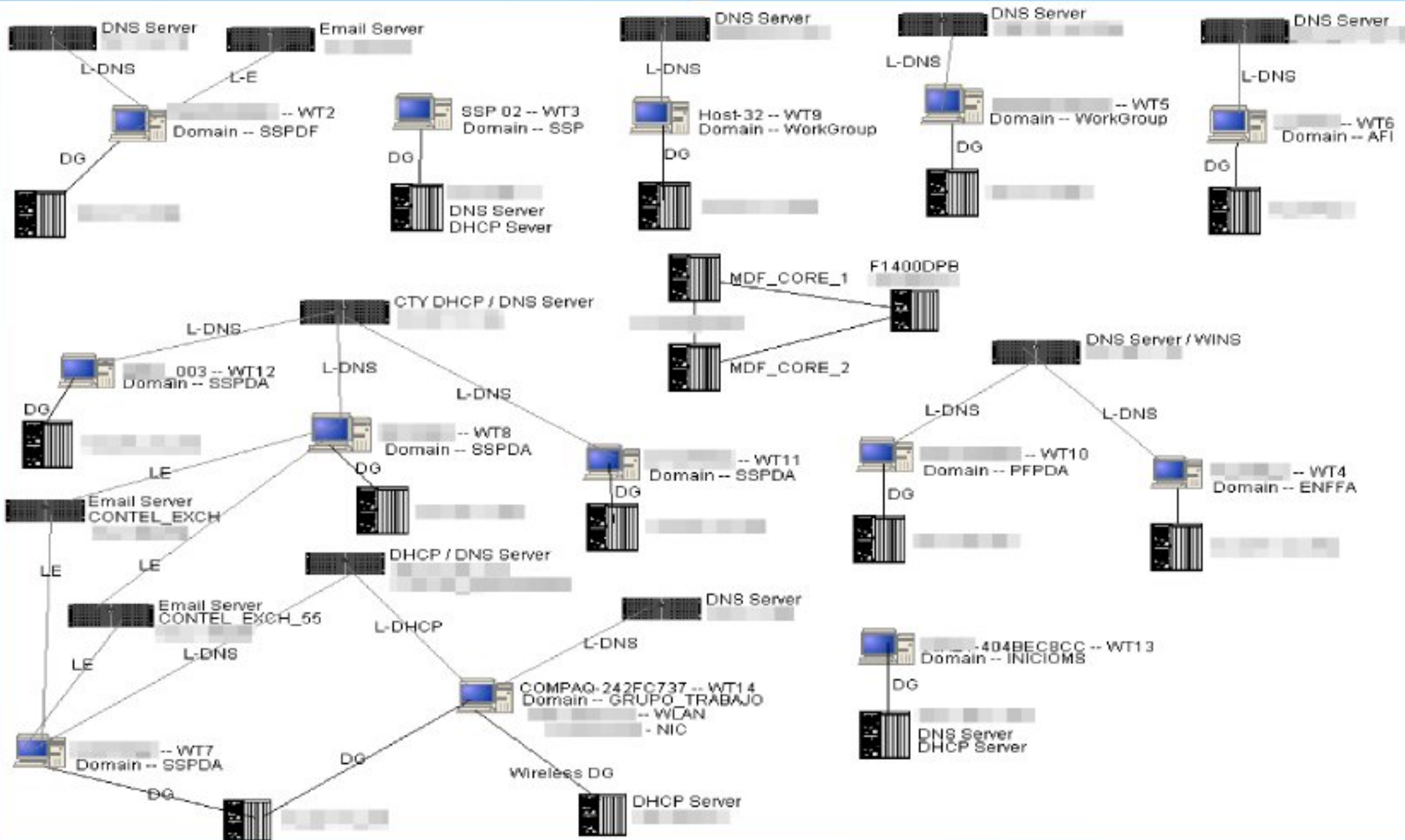

- GOAL: support Homeland Security requirements

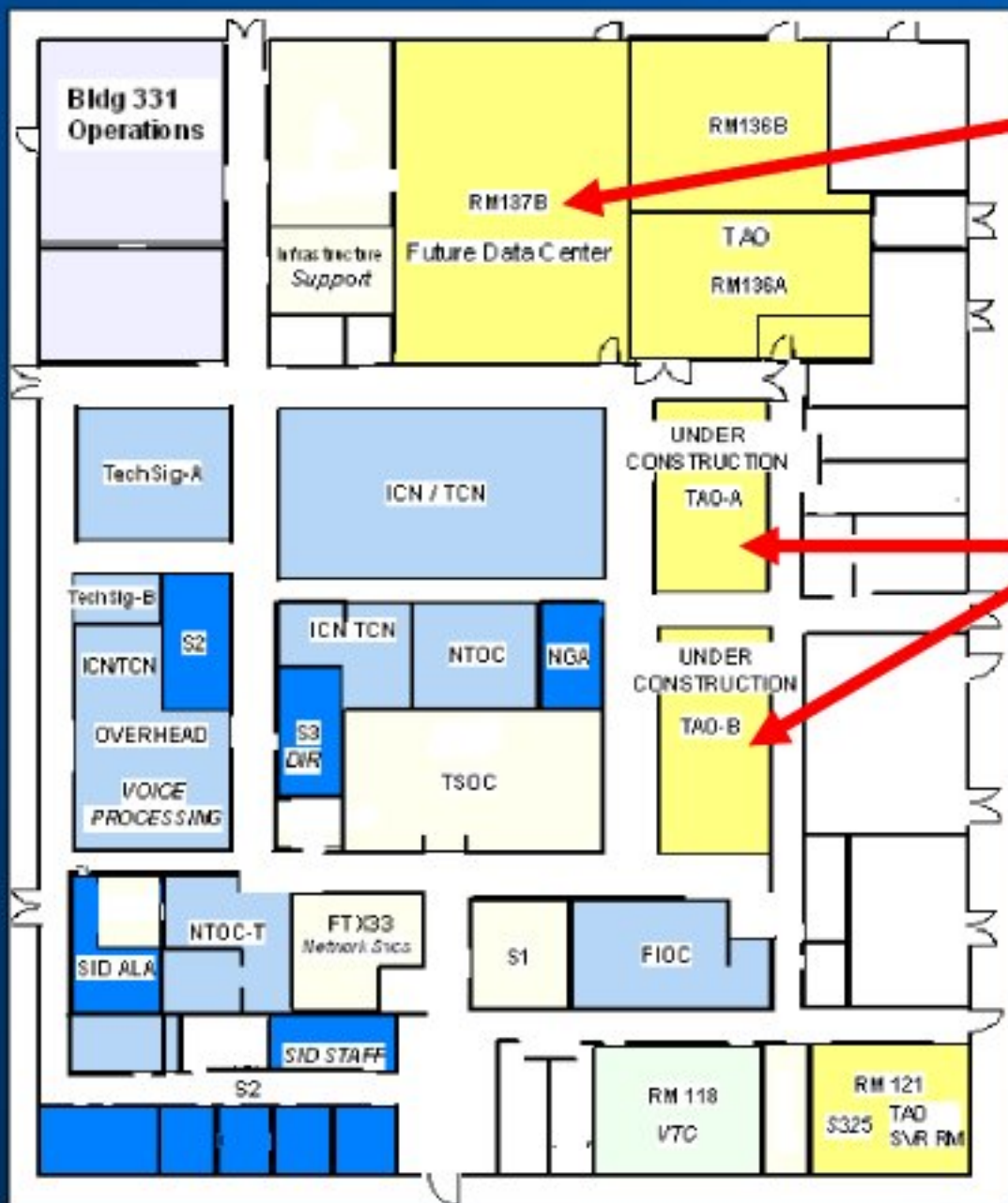

• Schedule for Space A & B

- Operational - 27 NOV
- Currently, TAO - 60 persons occupying 39 desks
- Space management enabled by TDYs, Training, Integrees, Shift-Work, Details
- End of 2008, potential for 13 more personnel
